This guide will help players unlock and craft a Pteranodon saddle Before players can craft anything useful in ARK: Survival Evolved, they first need to unlock its engram. Each level up grants upgrades to a player's many stats, and gives access to a new level of engram points. While each new engram points to unlock, players will receive several engram points per level-up. This makes it possible to save some for a not-yet-unlocked engram or simply ignore ones they don't see themselves needing. Without cheats, it's not possible for players to unlock every single engram on offer, so it's best to focus on only taking engrams that a player (or their tribe) needs. It's all too easy for a player to accidentally kill a Pteranodon while trying to knock it out due to its low health pool, so sneaking up on one while it rests to restrain it with a Bola or attack it with some punches followed by a tranquilizer arrow are the recommended strategies. After the Pteranodon has been knocked out, players will then need to add food to its inventory to tame it.
