



Looking forward to discussin the issue of "Intent Filter Verification Service has stopped" on your Pixel 4a 5g running LineageOS for microg 19. From what you've read, this service is supposed to handle various tasks, such as calling another application based on its type. However, the logs from logcat don't seem to point directly to anything. I'm not sure if using microg instead of Google Play Services is the cause of the issue, but we can try to investigate further. The first thing you should do is check the device's logs again, looking for any repeated errors or patterns that might give us a clue about what's going on. You can also try restarting your device and see if the issue persists. Another possible solution is to disable any recently installed apps or services that might be interfering with the "Intent Filter Verification Service". If you're not sure which app is causing the issue, you can try disabling all of them one by one until the problem goes away. If none of these solutions work, it might be necessary to perform a factory reset on your device. This will erase all of your data, so make sure you back up anything important before doing so. In any case, keep in mind that using microg instead of Google Play Services might have some implications for the functionality of certain apps and services on your device. You may need to adjust your settings or find alternative solutions to get everything working properly again. ### Sorry I don't have a solution for you but since you are using LineageOS+microG on a Pixel phone, you might be interested in switching to CalyxOS as they seem to already have a workaround in place even though the bug isn't fixed yet. See here under "Issues": Relevant commit: /7976 As a bonus, with CalyxOS you also get better security than just LineageOS+microG thanks to bootloader relocking. I am suffered by that bug too. I cant see any harm by this, but its annoying. The patch in CalyxOS is just to hide that problem as a workaround. Reactions: jonfocker's So I ended up following @john "fix" the issue. I guess Calxy is a perfect fit for my needs anyway (microg, locked boot loader, great polished daily driver) so Ill probably stick with it unless I end up with a phone that is not supported.
