Pistoia blues 2025

From June 27 to July 15, 2025, the Tuscan town of Pistoia will once again transform into a global hub for blues, rock, and storytelling with the 44th edition of the Pistoia Blues Festival. Set in the heart of the historic city, the festival offers an unforgettable experience for international travelers looking to combine top-tier live music with local charm, cultural attractions, and summer vibes. Concerts take place in the stunning Piazza Duomo, one of Italy’s most atmospheric squares, blending Renaissance architecture with the raw energy of live music. This year’s headliners include: Beth Hart (June 27), the Grammy-nominated blues powerhouse, in her only Italian summer date. Marcus King (July 4), a rising star in blues-rock, known for his soul-stirring guitar work and vocals. Blackberry Smoke & Paul Gilbert (July 10), for fans of Southern rock and classic guitar mastery. Queens of the Stone Age (July 15), who will close the festival with their explosive rock sound, supported by UK band The Amazons. The festival also showcases Italian musical storytelling with a “Storytellers” series featuring: Brunori Sas (July 5), an acclaimed singer-songwriter known for poetic, introspective lyrics. Francesco Gabbani (July 9), who rose to fame with catchy songs rich in cultural references. Gianna Nannini (July 13), Italy’s rock queen, returning to Pistoia with her European tour Sei nell’anima. Pistoia Blues isn’t just about big names. The “Blues City” series (July 4 – August 8) fills the city’s historic streets and squares with free live performances in jazz, folk, indie, and soul, inviting visitors to explore Pistoia beyond the main venue and soak in its vibrant atmosphere . On July 12, the festival pays homage to local blues legend Nick Beattini with Un Blues per Nick, a heartfelt, free-entry evening featuring some of Italy’s most respected blues artists. Thanks to a collaboration with Fondazione Pistoia Musei, ticket holders can purchase a discounted Buren Pass, granting access to the exhibition Daniel Buren. Fare, Disfare, Rifare and to all four museum sites, including the historic Palazzo Buontalenti and the Antico Palazzo dei Vescovi. It’s a perfect way to balance music with a deeper dive into contemporary and classical art . A special exhibition titled “Pistoia Blues – Oltre il Palco” will run from June 21 to July 15 at the Palazzo Comunale. It traces the history of the festival through posters, backstage photography, and interactive installations—a great way to understand how deeply music is woven into the city’s identity . Pistoia is easily reachable by train from Florence (under 1 hour) and offers a more relaxed and authentic Tuscan experience away from the tourist crowds. The A11 “Firenze - Mare” highway provides direct access to Pistoia, with several exits available for those coming from different directions: Exits: Prato Ovest (for Quarrata, Agliana, and Montale), Pistoia, Montecatini Terme, Chiesina Uzzanese (for Pescia) Here are the recommended routes depending on your origin: From Milan: Take the A1 Motorway towards Florence, and at the Florence North interchange, follow the A11 towards Pisa. From Rome: Similar to the Milan route, with the A1 connecting to the A11 at Florence North. From Genoa - Livorno: Use the A12 to the Pisa North interchange, then follow the A1 towards Florence and the A11 “Firenze Mare” towards Pisa. In 2020, King collaborated with Dan Auerbach to record his solo debut, El Dorado, which earned him a GRAMMY® Award nomination for Best Americana Album. He has shared the stage with artists like Chris Stapleton, Greta Van Fleet, and Nathaniel Rateliff, and has also performed at major festivals like Stagecoach. Legendary producer Rick Rubin, known for his work with artists like Adele and Johnny Cash, was immediately struck by Marcus’ unique guitar playing, his unmistakable voice, and the depth of his songwriting. After attending one of his live performances, Rubin reached out to propose working together. This collaboration led to the creation of Mood Swings in 2024, an album blending soul and timeless sounds that remain ever-relevant. In his music, King addresses themes such as pain, addiction, and mental health. His voice, steeped in emotion, conveys the weight of regrets and lived experiences, often marked by alcohol and mistakes made in distant hotels. Additionally, he has launched several initiatives in support of mental health, including a guitar auction in collaboration with MusicCares.
