The chart shows that Hablar will change to Habla for the pronoun T, e.g. T habla primero (You speak first!). It is not necessary to add USTEDES (you) to refer to the whole class. All these verbs will change their ending according to the chart presented above, except for CORREGIR that will change to CORRIJA(N) and PRACTICAR to PRACTIQUE(N).
